The Greens and Lighting upgrades were done under the MBRC 5-year plan which forms part of our lease and is a blueprint for Greens and infrastructure upgrades going forward.

Projects attracting Grants and Sponsorship completed in the past 2 years.

The Club is now in discussion with various parties to discuss finance and logistics for the Upgrade to the Carpet on the Indoor Green.

Please find attached a breakdown of costs associated with the Infrastructure Projects.

The 5-year plan will now have to be revised to suit our infrastructure projects going forward ncluding the resurfacing of "B "green and sustainable water for the Synthetic greens.


